Never carry fireworks in your pocket or shoot them in metal or glass containers.

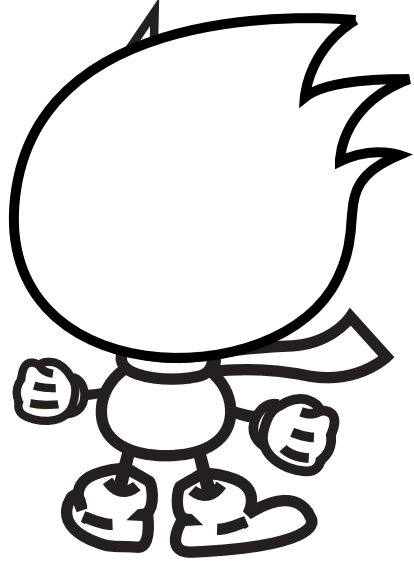
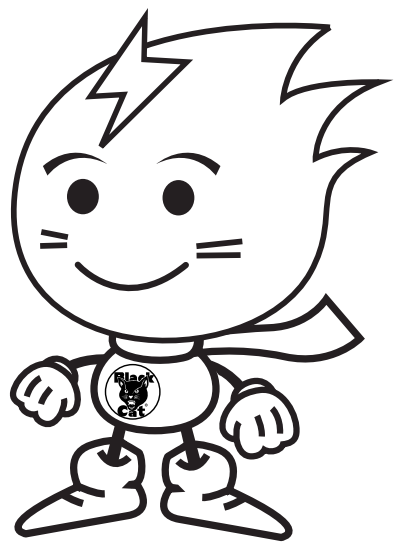
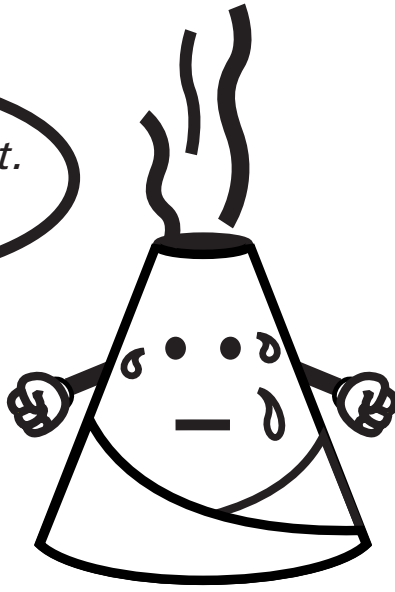


Light only one firework at a time. Wear eye protection and never have any portion of your body over the firework.

Launch rocket from a tube or rack!

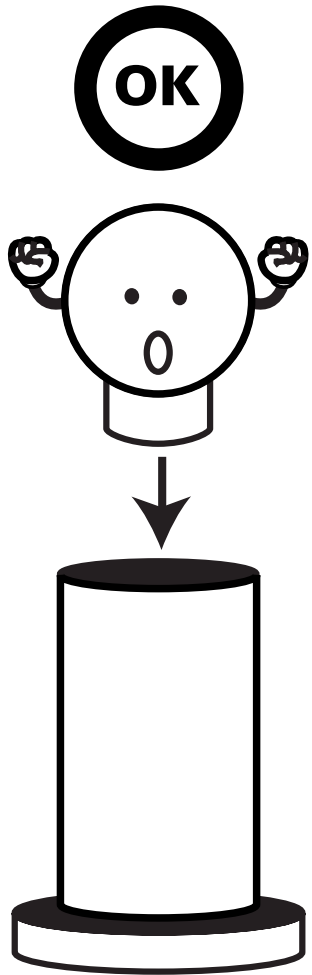


*Don't experiment.
Never re-light.*



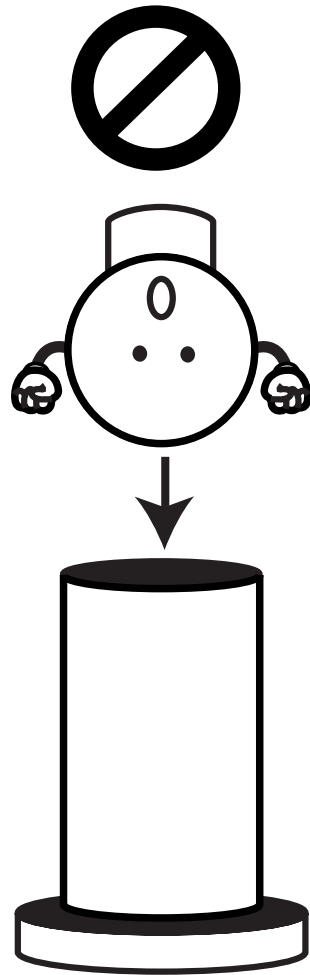
Don't experiment with homemade fireworks & never attempt to re-light a firework.

Never point or throw fireworks at another person.

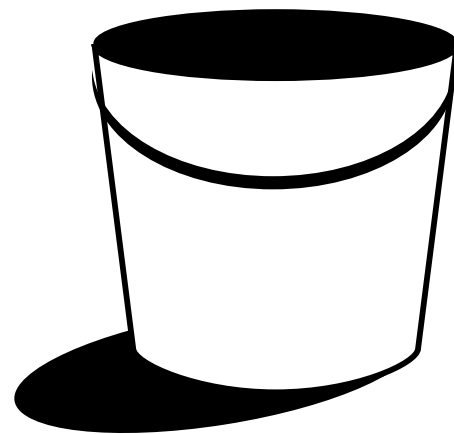
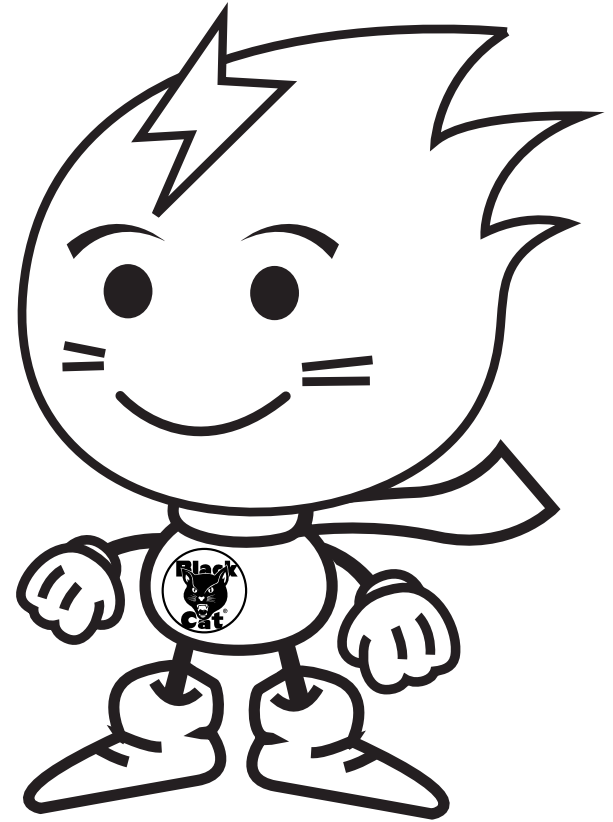
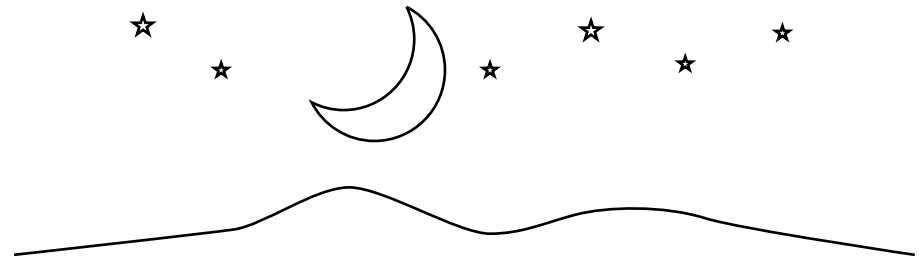


Good!

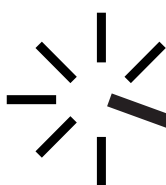
Put ball into tube with flat end down and with fuse extending out of tube.



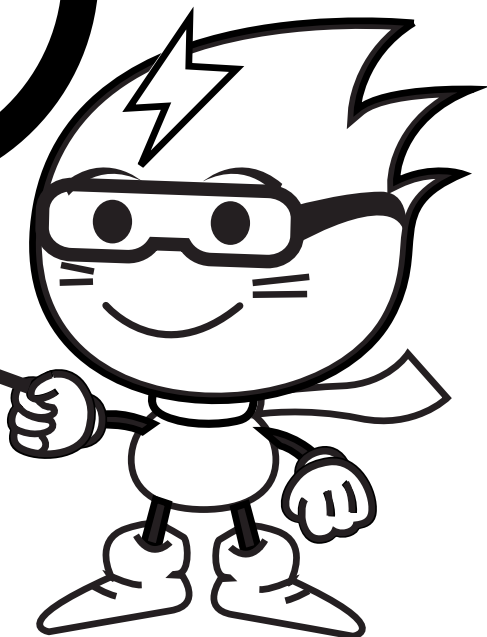
Dangerous!
